Rules:

1. The Tournament will be played according to the fide Laws (Swiss laws).
2. The tournament will be conducted on the 2nd and 3rd weekends of Feb. 2012 [Feb 9-11 & Feb 16-18, 2012]. For timing refer the fixture.
3. The competitions are open to all Indian Nationals and nationals of Indian origin in Qatar.
4. Players have to produce proof of age, if required. age will be calculated as on **1st Feb. 2012**
5. Minimum number of entries required for one event is three (3).
6. Entry fees for under 14 yrs QR.20/-each and above 14 yrs. QRS. 30/-
7. Players should report to the concerned coordinators 30 minutes before the match time.
8. Walk-over will be given, if a player does not report within 15 minutes after the schedule time
9. No refund will be made unless the event is cancelled.
10. ICC reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason.
11. **Last date for submitting entry form is 10.00 P.M. on 06/02/2012.**
12. The above conditions are subject to change and decision of the ICC is final.
13. Fixtures of the entry of the entry of tournament will be displayed at ICC notice board on **08/02/2012**
14. Venue of the Chess Tournament will be at ICC Premises.
15. Mobile Phone strictly prohibits in Tournament Hall.
16. Each payer must play through the entire tournament however, if a player has to withdraw due to Circumstances beyond his/her control the player should inform the tournament coordinator.
17. The session to play shall be one Hour.
18. The Final positions of the players shall be determined by the total number of points scored.
19. The position of players, which finish with the same number of points, shall be determined by the application of the progressive score.
20. A player who wins his game scores one point (1) A player who loses his game scores No points (0) and a player who draws his game scores half/A/point (½)
